Art360 is an innovative collaborative program between Community Support Services, Inc. and Chicago Zoological Society-Brookfield Zoo that brings art, learning, creativity and social inclusion full circle. Art360 staff will engage young adults with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities in hands on, therapeutic, and social activities through the creative arts and the social atmosphere of the zoo. During this 10 week program, individuals will observe various animals in their habitats, while enhancing social skills and discovering new forms of self-expression through art techniques. The program culminates with individuals showcasing their works of art in a final exhibition. Art360 is geared toward teens and young adults with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities (I/DD). There is an activity fee associated with this program.
