Supported Employment Services

CSS' Individualized Employment Plans ensure success with a 4-Step process:

Step 1: Comprehensive Assessment

- Identify marketable skills & abilities
- 95% of participants ready to work

Step 2: Job Readiness Training

- Weekly meetings with CSS Specialist
- Focus: self-presentation/social skills

Step 3: Job Matching

- CSS Job Developer finds 'good fit' match for employer and participant
- Matching on skills/tasks & work environment

Step 4: Job Coaching & Retention

- CSS Job Coach learns job and trains participant on site
- CSS provides ongoing support to employment partner and participant to further ensure job retention
