Community Support Services' newest community art summer program **Summer Site Seekers** is designed to engage participants in a fun two day experience that is sure to keep its audience captivated. Participants will attend field trips related to the arts followed by a day of art making at CSS Academy. Each day will begin and end with group discussion in which participants will engage in reflective conversations regarding reactions to the day's activities. The program will consist of 8 two-day sessions that meet once a week on Tuesdays. Participants can register for one session or all of them! Each session consists of one field trip day (9am-2pm) and one art studio day (9am-12pm) for a total of 8 hours over the course of two weeks. Field trips will be taken at various locations around the Chicagoland area. Activities will always begin at the CSS Academy, and then participants will receive CSS transportation to the field trip location or remain in the art studio for the class. Material cost, snacks and transportation are included in price.

Note: Limited to 10 Participants per session. Participants should feel comfortable with getting their hands dirty with materials such as paint, glue, dirt and or clay. Participants should also be able to handle basic cutting tools such as scissors, needles and thread, x-acto knives and other sharp objects. Participants should also be open to walking on field trip days.
